#### PORTUGAL FIGHTS BACK

After session two Portuguese pairs end up on the top two spots of the table. José Moraes - João Paes de Carvalho now lead the field following their 64.05% in the first session with 63.77%. Maintaining second place are Paulo Gonçalves Pereira (last year's pairs' winner) and Nuno Paz, just 1.5% behind. First foreign pair are the Icelanders Einarsson and Magnusson also with two sessions above 60%. Yesterday's winners took a tumble just out of the top

ten after a surprising 49.35%.

Session winners were the Bulgarians Christo Dumev and Ivan Tanev with 66.56% just followed by M. J. Lara - M. Capucho and E. Jonsson - S. R. Eiriksson, three pairs that after a disappointing first session managed to get themselves in the top eight.

As for the locals, the two Ribeiro brothers - Fernando and Armando - take the lead after a very good 58.99%.

It's a tight race and everything is up for grabs yet!

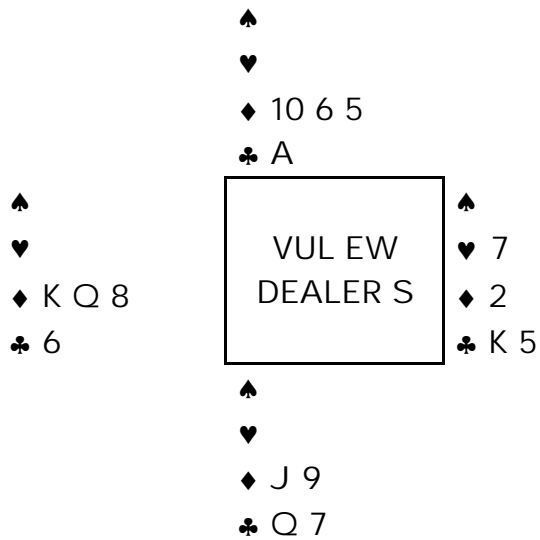

The lead was a small heart. Manel took the first trick with dummy's ace, playing the 7 from hand. A losing finesse of the king of trumps followed. It wasn't easy for South to see that the ♥3 was a discouraging card (playing low encouraging), specially after the lead had been taken in dummy, so another heart followed. Declarer now drew trumps ending in hand and played king of hearts (discarding a club) and a heart ruffed. The

fifth spade had to be cashed now, and after a diamond to the ace, the last heart was led in this end position:

North had to give away the twelfth trick, whatever he did. A superbly timed squeeze that earned the pair a cold, and well deserved, top.

Paulo Gonçalves Pereira and Nuno Paz maintain their second position after yesterday's session. A strong defence is a trademark of this first time partnership. Board 27.

After 1♠ - pass - 2♠ -all pass, both partners weren't very pleased to see the dummy. It seemed that they should be in a partscore themselves. The lead was a small spade. After taking the King with the Ace, declarer played a spade to the Queen and a diamond from

dummy. The King of diamonds made the trick and another diamond followed, W taking the trick. He exited with his third diamond, ruffed in dummy. A club to the Ace allowed declarer to play his last diamond, which W (Nuno Paz) correctly refused to ruff with the 10, and was won by dummy's last trump (the 9). Now declarer tried a heart to the King and Nuno took the Ace and Queen. He followed with the Queen and small club, made by Paulo's King, who promptly played the thirteenth club promoting partner's ♠10. A nicely timed defence to get only a slightly below average board. (36 out of 76 Matchpoints).
