4♠ Lay Down

If you played the first round on the first three tables yesterday, you probably played 4♠ on board 5 (I didn't, I played 6♠!):

Board 5. Dealer N. N/S Vul.

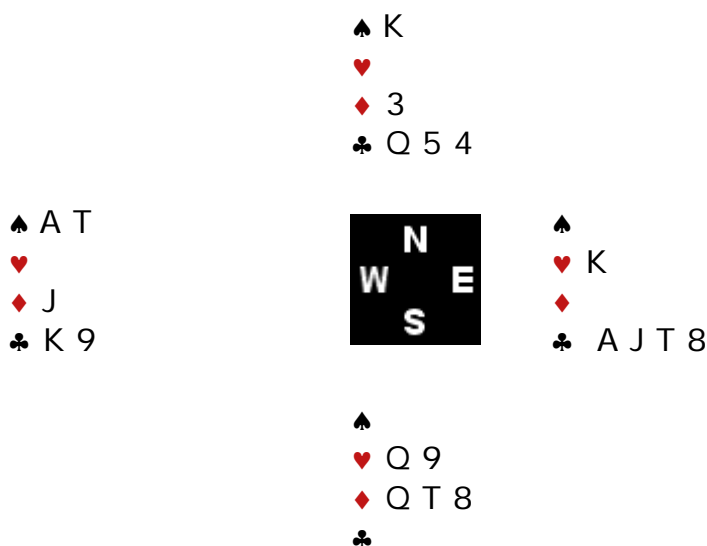

This is an interesting hand. Care must be taken not to go down on a contract that seems very safe. You cannot afford to draw trumps, whatever the lead, for West will duck twice and then cash the clubs. Nor, it seems, can you start on diamonds because if trumps are 3-2 you may get ruffed on the third round and have no way to reach dummy. If you escaped a trump lead it seems the best way to ten tricks is to cash two top diamonds early. When they don't get ruffed you can cross-ruff, making two diamond tricks, 3 club ruffs in dummy, the ♥A, two hearts ruffed small in hand and the King and Queen of trumps.

On a trump lead, West will duck the first round. Now your best line seems to be to take another rounds of trumps. West will have to duck again, or you will be home making 4 spade tricks the ♥A and 5 diamond tricks. When you get the bad news – the 4-1 trump break – you can ruff two hearts in hand and one club in dummy, using the diamonds as entries, reaching this end position:

Board 5. Dealer N. N/S Vul.



Now you simply play a diamond to the Queen, and when West follows you are home, making your tenth trick with the ♠K "en passant".
